

# A to Z Recycling Guide

For households





## Sorting waste in the correct manner

It's important to recycle as much as we can and to put as little waste into our rubbish bins as possible. As well as saving money, recycling also reduces energy and water use and helps preserve our world's finite resources. Please find information in this guide how to better sort your waste.

#### Food waste

Bread and pastries, fruit and vegetable, fish and meat (cooked or uncooked), tea bags and coffee grounds, cooked and raw food, are examples of what you sort as food waste. Put leftovers from cooking or eating inside the brown paper bag intended for food waste. When the bag is filled up to the marked line, place the bag in the compartment or container intended for food waste in your bin. When you are out of paper bags, collect new ones in a local grocery store.

Be careful not to mix any plastic, packaging, medicine or nappies with your food waste, as this doesn't belong in the food waste bag.

#### **Residual waste**

Residual waste is leftovers once you have sorted out hazardous waste, food waste, packaging, newspapers, and recycled paper. Residual waste includes things such as cigarette butts, snuff sachets, vacuum cleaner bags, sanitary towels, chewing gum, toothbrushes, swabs and cotton balls. Put the residual waste in a plastic bag and not loose in the compartment or container intended for residual waste. Seal the bag tightly.

#### Packaging, newspapers and recycled paper

If you have the subscription form Standard put packaging, newspapers and recycled paper directly in the bin, and avoid storing it in your kitchen or garage. If your household is connected to the subscription form Central uppsamlingsplats, dispose packaging, newspapers and recycled paper there. If you don't have packaging sorting near your home leave packaging, newspapers and recyclable paper in the designated containers at a Recycling Station.

#### Hazardous waste

Hazardous waste is something that is harmful to humans, animals and our environment if left in the wrong place. It must therefore be sorted out and dealt with separately. Tins containing paint, glue, or solvent residues are hazardous waste. Drop off your hazardous waste at a Recycling Centre.

#### **Electrical waste**

Leave your dispose used light sources, electrical items and batteries at a manned Recycling Centre.

If you have a box for electrical items and batteries, hang it to one of your bins on the waste collection day. After the bin has been emptied, take the box back inside.

#### **Recycling Centres**

In Ludvika and Smedjebacken municipalities, there are four Recycling Centres: Björnhyttan, Fredriksberg, Nytäppan and Nor, where you dispose bulky household items, hazardous waste, electrical items and garden waste.
